Seven Network receives seven Kennedy Award nominations

The Seven Network has secured seven nominations across five categories in this year's NRMA Kennedy Awards for Excellence in NSW Journalism.

Seven News team including crime reporter Robert Ovadia, investigative producer Paula Doneman, artist Tony Fox and editor Duncan Farr were nominated in the Outstanding Investigative Reporting category for their investigation into the Australian Defence Force's so-called "Jedi Council" sex ring.

Robert and Paula combined their networks of Defence and Police contacts to reveal in a succession of stories all the main players, their ranks, details of the scandal and cover-up.

The investigation also earned the Seven News team a nomination for the Harry Potter Award for Outstanding Television News Reporting.

Sunday Night chief investigations reporter Ross Coulthart and Steve Pennells' investigation into the death of Lisa Harnum and convicted killer Simon Gittany was recognised with two nominations for Outstanding Television Current Affairs Reporting and Outstanding Investigative Reporting.

Sunday Night constructed a replica apartment from which Gittany was found guilty of throwing his then fiancée Lisa Harnum off the balcony to her death, and called upon experts to investigate both the Prosecution and Defence versions of events.

Seven News state political reporter Lee Jeloscek was nominated in the Outstanding Political Reporting category for an entire body of work, while Seven News senior cameraman Paul Walker was nominated for the Gary Ticehurst Award for Outstanding News Camera Coverage for a series of reports on Syria's civil war and humanitarian crisis.

The Seven Network is a proud sponsor of the NRMA Kennedy Awards, which honours the memories of six industry legends including journalist Les Kennedy.

Winners will be announced at a black tie event at Royal Randwick Ballroom on Friday August 8, 2014.
