Seven's Australian Open women's final annihilates cricket

Seven's Australian Open women's final peaked at a massive 2.63 million combined viewers last night, with a five city metro average of 1.148 million more than doubling Ten's cricket.

Popular winner **Li Na** clinched her first Australian Open title as the women's final averaged 1.79 million combined viewers, with a metro average of 1.38 million for the 98 minute match.

The one hour preview show also had a huge combined peak of 1.64 million, with a 1.08 million peak in the metro areas.

The gripping battle delivered Seven another nightly win with a 25.9 per cent network share, ahead of Nine with 13.8 per cent and Ten's with BBL cricket a dismal 12.3 per cent.

The broadcast has now reached more than 13 million Australians combined over the first 13 days of the tournament, and 8.7 million in the metro areas.

Tonight world no.1 **Rafael Nadal** is out to claim his 14th Grand Slam title against new Swiss no.1 **Stanislas 'The Stanimal' Wawrinka** LIVE from 6.30pm AEDT.
