Statement from Seven on AFP

The Seven Network welcomes the decision made by the AFP that its investigation is no longer warranted and it will be returning all material seized under search warrants executed on Seven's premises on 18 February.

Seven noted that it was awaiting judgment in the Federal Court proceedings heard last week which seek to have the warrants set aside.

"Seven was always frank and co-operative with the AFP as to our position in the negotiations for an interview with Schapelle Corby and believes that the use and execution of search warrants was excessive and unnecessary," a Seven spokesman said. "As the matter remains before the Court, we do not intend to make further comment at this stage. The Federal Court proceedings are not affected."
